## What do you do if...

- 1. Pre-match you look at the coaches' challenge match sheets and you notice that one school does not have the athletic director's signature
- 2. You are about to start the team introductions and a coach advises you that his second singles player is making up a test and will be a little late
- 3. You are called to a court during the ten minute warm-up and one player has aggravated a shoulder injury and cannot continue
- 4. A player calls you to the court during the match and informs you that his opponent's father who is among the spectators is reacting negatively to his line calls
- 5. A coach comes to you and complains that a doubles player on the opposing team is foot-faulting
- 6. It is 4-2 in the second set tie-break and a player calls you to the court and asks for a toilet break
- 7. It is 6-1 in a second set tiebreak. The player who is ahead has already received a code violation and he misses an easy overhead and he throws his racquet in anger
- 8. During the first set of a match you notice that one of the players is not in a team uniform
- 9. You glace over and observe someone, who is not one of the coaches, is talking to a player at the fence during a changeover
- 10. A ball falls out of a player's pocket and on to the court during the playing of a point. The opponent stops play and claims the point. You are called to the court
- 11. A player calls you to the court and complains that his opponent is serving before he is ready to receive the serve
- 12. You hear one of the coaches or spectators frequently calling out comments like "That's it, stay aggressive", "Move your feet" & "Keep attacking the Net"
- 13. You are standing on-court and you overrule a ball which a player called out, but the player returned the ball to the opponent's court. The overruled player claims a replay of the point
- 14. During a match a coach says that he has an emergency, has to leave and will be back in 15 minutes. There are no other coaches from that school at the match
