



TENNIS : What would you do if...

1. A match is midway through the first set and you notice that one of the players is not wearing the team uniform shirt. You either missed this at team introductions or the player changed after he got out on the court. What do you do now?
2. A player calls you on the court and complains that his opponent is not calling the score. You instruct the opponent to call the score before each point and stay on court for a few moments to be sure he does so. Fifteen minutes later you are called over again and the player tells you that his opponent is still not calling the score.
3. During a match you are officiating, a coach calls you over and informs you that he has given a code violation, point penalty to a player on his team.
4. During a match you are officiating, a coach calls you over and informs you that he has given a code violation, point penalty to a player on the opposing team.
5. Pre match you are looking over the challenge match sheet and you notice that no assistant coach is listed. The match begins and you observe that a second person, in addition to the coach, is speaking to players at changeovers. You approach this person and she informs you that she is the assistant coach.
6. Pre match the coach informs you that her third singles player is absent and she is substituting a JV player in that slot. You check the challenge match sheet and the player's name does not appear with any challenge match information.
7. Pre match the coach informs you that his first and second singles players are missing and he plans to move his third singles player to first singles and put JV players in the remaining singles positions so as to keep his doubles teams intact.
8. You see a heated discussion in progress on a nearby singles court and go over to investigate. One player informs you that, during a rally, he returned a ball that, on the fly, hit another ball that was at rest in the doubles alley. He claims the ball in play is therefore dead and he gets the point. His opponent objects. Ruling?
